

OBJECTIVES _ AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL EQUESTRIAN COACHES ASSOCIATION Inc.

1. Form an Association of a national professional body for Australian equestrian coaches to
 - 1.1. represent its members acting at all times with integrity, transparency, fairness and equity in their best interests and in the interests of the future of equestrian coaching in Australia:
 - 1.1.1. **Nationally**, the Association shall represent the interests of **ANECA** members from all States and Territories, to the equestrian sport's governing body and to all other individuals or entities with which it may be necessary and appropriate to interact on members' behalf, and
 - 1.1.2. **Internationally**, the Association shall represent **ANECA** members at coaching conferences and any other such meetings or conventions, in its capacity as the national professional body for Australian equestrian coaches.
2. To offer membership of the Association that supports different levels of coaching and the diverse range of equestrian activities in which coaches are involved in the community.
3. Without limiting the Board in setting eligibility criteria for membership, membership will be open to
 - 3.1. Australian accredited equestrian coaches from the formal Olympic equestrian disciplines
 - 3.2. Australian coaches in the informal equestrian community sector
 - 3.3. Overseas-accredited coaches who are either residents or visiting in Australia, and
 - 3.4. Persons or organisations that can assist ANECA to meet its objectives.
